BAJA Net Preamble

Good morning everyone and welcome to the BAJA California Maritime Net, the Boater's Friendly Net. It is a public service net for boaters and RV'ers along the coasts of California, BAJA California, the Sea of Cortez, Mainland Mexico AND as far out in the Pacific as we can reach. We are a friendly group and invite anyone, anywhere, to join us as long as you are licensed to transmit on this frequency. In an emergency we will talk to anyone with or without a license.

The BAJA net opens officially each day at 0800 Pacific Time on this frequency, 7233.5 kHz. We'll have a weather report at 08:15. Any use of that weather information is strictly the responsibility of the using party. You'll have a chance to ask questions after the report.

This is a controlled net so please do not transmit until invited to do so by Net Control or one of the designated relay stations. When check-ins are requested please respond with just the suffix of your call sign using international phonetics. When called upon, come back with your complete call sign, name, location and any traffic you wish to pass.

- 6 Final round from relays first, then Net control.
- 7 Thank relays and weatherman: "we couldn't do it without you".
- 9 Close the Net: Thank you all for being here. We hope to see you again at the same time, same frequency. The net is now closed.
